YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED, pursuant to Executive Law § 63(8) and § 2302(a) of the New York Civil Practice Law and Rules, to appear and attend before the Special Deputies to the First Deputy Attorney General, on April 19, 2021 at 9:30 AM, or any agreed upon adjourned date or time, at One Liberty Plaza, 38th Floor, New York, New York 10006 to testify in connection with an investigation into allegations of and circumstances surrounding sexual harassment claims made against Governor Cuomo, or any matter which the Attorney General deems pertinent thereto.

TAKE NOTICE that the Attorney General deems the testimony commanded by this Subpoena to be relevant and material to an investigation and inquiry undertaken in the public interest.


TAKE NOTICE that the examination may be recorded by stenographic, videographic and/or audio means.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that Your disobedience of this Subpoena, by failing to appear and attend and testify on the date, time and place stated above or on any agreed upon adjourned date or time, **may subject You to penalties and other lawful punishment** under § 2308 of the New York Civil Practice Law and Rules and/or other statutes.

TO: ALL TROOPS AND STATIONS

IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT VACANCIES WILL EXIST IN THE NEAR FUTURE FOR THE POSITIONS OF INVESTIGATOR AND TROOPER IN THE PROTECTIVE SERVICES UNIT IN ALBANY AND NEW YORK CITY.

MEMBERS REQUESTING ASSIGNMENT MUST POSSESS A SATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE EVALUATION RATING. TROOPERS MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) YEARS OF SERVICE AS A UNIFORM TROOPER. AS PER ARTICLE 2B5 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE MANUAL, A REQUEST FOR ASSIGNMENT TO THE PROTECTIVE SERVICES UNIT IS INDEPENDENT OF ANY OTHER TROOP TRANSFER REQUEST.

MEMBERS ARE SELECTED TO SERVE IN THE UNIT AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SUPERINTENDENT AND ARE SUBJECT TO REASSIGNMENT AT ANY TIME. ASSIGNMENT TO THIS DETAIL REQUIRES A MINIMUM COMMITMENT OF ONE YEAR.

MEMBERS ARE SUBJECT TO REASSIGNMENT AND TRANSFER TO THEIR TROOP OF ORIGIN OR OTHER TROOP CONSISTENT WITH THE NEEDS OF DIVISION AND CURRENT COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS.

MEMBERS EXPRESSING AN INTEREST IN SERVING WITH THE UNIT SHOULD FORWARD A MEMORANDUM ELECTRONICALLY THROUGH CHANNELS, OUTLINING THEIR QUALIFICATIONS, TO THE OFFICE OF THE FIRST DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 1, 2017.

ABSTRACTS SHALL BE SCANNED AND SUBMITTED SEPARATELY IN A FOLLOW UP EMAIL TO THE FIRST DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. IN ADDITION, SUPERVISORY ENDORSEMENTS ARE TO INCLUDE A DEFINITIVE RECOMMENDATION BY TROOP OR DETAIL COMMANDER RELATIVE TO THE CANDIDACY OF THOSE MEMBERS WHO REQUEST ASSIGNMENT TO THIS DETAIL.

BASED UPON A REVIEW OF THE MATERIAL SUBMITTED, MEMBERS MAY BE SUBJECT TO AN INTERVIEW.

TROOP AND DETAIL COMMANDERS SHALL BRING THE CONTENTS OF THIS MESSAGE TO THE ATTENTION OF ALL MEMBERS IN THEIR COMMAND.
